

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstracts related to new research at Medical Research Institute will be published in the MRI Abstract Book after being peer reviewed. Opportunity for oral presentation or poster presentation will be given according to the paper. Abstract committee will decide on the mode of publication (oral / poster).

Already published abstracts are also welcome to be included in the MRI research bulletin. If you are submitting a published abstract please provide the details.

Please fill the declaration form with your abstract.

Abstract submission guidelines:

Title of the abstract

- The title of the abstract should be short and it should be relevant to the research.
- The first letter of the first word in the title should be a capital letter and other letters should be simple letters.
- Key words: Maximum up to 05

Name(s) of the author(s)

- The name of the author(s) and the institution(s) should be given with the title of the abstract.
- Authors surname should be come first before the initial(s). Do not put dots within the initials.
- Don't include prefix such as Prof., Dr., Mr., Ms., etc...
- Separate the authors' names with commas (do not include academic degrees or specialty certification)
- Underline only the name of the corresponding author.

Affiliation

- Authors' professional affiliations at the time of the study should be mentioned.
- Affiliations should be listed in italics in the order in which the authors' names are given
- If authors do not all have the same affiliation, the authors' last names should be given in superscript numbers to indicate affiliation

Abstract structure

- Body of the abstract should include
- Introduction and objective(s)
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion and Conclusions
- The abstract body should not exceed 250 words (Limited to one page)

Text: Times Roman font size 12.

Tables, Figures and Diagrams: Allowed if it is essential, but limited to one.

Source of funding

Mention the information on any grants or the source of funding used to conduct the research at the end of the abstract

Ethical clearance

Provide information about the ethical clearance of your research (Optional).
